Overview

This bill creates an adoption advisory task force.

Section

- 1 Adoption advisory task force.
 - **Subd. 1. Creation; membership.** Directs the commissioner of human services to appoint an 18 member task force to study and make recommendations regarding content, reorganization, and recodification of statutes and rules related to adoption.
 - **Subd. 2. Expenses.** Provides that members shall not receive a per diem, but shall receive reimbursement for expenses as provided in section 15.059, subdivision 6.
 - **Subd. 3. Duties; report.** Provides that the task force shall submit a written report to the house and senate committees having jurisdiction over adoption with the following information: whether adoption and birth record statutes and rules need to be written to reflect best practice; whether existing adoption and birth record statutes and rules need to be recodified; and proposed legislation to implement the recommended changes.
