Overview

This bill creates an adoption advisory task force.

Section

1 Adoption advisory task force.

Subd. 1. Creation; membership. Directs the commissioner of human services to appoint an 18 member task force to study and make recommendations regarding content, reorganization, and recodification of statutes and rules related to adoption.

Subd. 2. Expenses. Provides that members shall not receive a per diem, but shall receive reimbursement for expenses as provided in section 15.059, subdivision 6.

Subd. 3. Duties; report. Provides that the task force shall submit a written report to the house and senate committees having jurisdiction over adoption with the following information: whether adoption and birth record statutes and rules need to be written to reflect best practice; whether existing adoption and birth record statutes and rules need to be recodified; and proposed legislation to implement the recommended changes.
