- 1** **Citation authority.** Allows the commissioner of natural resources (DNR) to issue a citation for someone not having a horse trail pass.
- 2** **Horse trail pass.** Requires anyone 16 years of age or older to have a horse trail pass with them when riding, leading, or driving a horse in state recreational areas. Allows the DNR and appointed issuing agents to sell the horse trail pass for a \$20 annual fee, and \$4 for a daily pass.
 - Subd. 5. Issuing fee.** Allows an issuing agent to charge a \$1 fee for their cost of issuance.
 - Subd. 6. Disposition of receipts.** Credits the horse trail pass fees to a new account and, except for DNR issuance fees for the electronic licensing system, the fees are appropriated to the commissioner for trail acquisition, development, maintenance and enforcement in state recreational areas. Authorizes a duplicate horse trail pass for \$2, with a 50 cent issuing fee.
- 3** **Effective date.** Makes the bill effective on January 1, 2007.
