### Overview

By law, a certain percentage of tax revenues from pari-mutuel pools is set aside for the Minnesota Breeders Fund, a fund established to promote the horse industry in Minnesota. This bill modifies the apportionment of Breeders Fund dollars among breeds racing at licensed Minnesota racetracks.

#### Section

- 1 Other categories.** Authorizes the Racing Commission to distribute money apportioned for the Arabian breed to owners who are Minnesota residents racing at either licensed Minnesota racetracks or at racetracks in border states.
