Overview

By law, a certain percentage of tax revenues from pari-mutuel pools is set aside for the Minnesota Breeders Fund, a fund established to promote the horse industry in Minnesota. This bill modifies the apportionment of Breeders Fund dollars among breeds racing at licensed Minnesota racetracks.

Other categories. Authorizes the Racing Commission to distribute money apportioned for the Arabian breed to owners who are Minnesota residents racing at either licensed Minnesota racetracks or at racetracks in border states.
