Overview

Under Minnesota's postsecondary enrollment options program, postsecondary institutions can offer college courses in high schools through an agreement between the governing board of a public system or a private postsecondary institution and a local school board. This bill prohibits the governing boards and institutions that sign these agreements from adopting a policy that would, in effect, limit the availability of courses offered in high schools throughout the state.
