Overview

Current law provides a lien for storage charges on motor vehicles left with a mechanic after repairs are made. The bill prevents this lien from accruing if the vehicle is registered in this state, there is a secured creditor on the title, and the storage lasts over five days, unless written notice is sent to all secured creditors by registered mail. It also specifies the contents of the notice.
