Overview

This bill eliminates the current requirement that the Metropolitan Council ("Met Council") review school district capital improvement programs.

1	Council review. Eliminates Met council review of school district capital improvement programs for compatibility and consistency with metropolitan systems plans.
2	Legislative findings. Amends the legislative findings of the Land Use Planning Act to eliminate a finding that school districts should be included in metropolitan area planning.

9	Application clause. Applies in the seven-county metropolitan area.
