Overview

This bill eliminates the current requirement that the Metropolitan Council ("Met Council") review school district capital improvement programs.

Section

- 1 **Council review.** Eliminates Met council review of school district capital improvement programs for compatibility and consistency with metropolitan systems plans.
- 2 **Legislative findings.** Amends the legislative findings of the Land Use Planning Act to eliminate a finding that school districts should be included in metropolitan area planning.
- 3 **Reference eliminated.** Eliminates reference to school districts in definition of capital improvement program.
- 4 **Reference eliminated.** Eliminates reference to school districts in statute requiring Met Council to provide planning assistance.
- 5 **Reference eliminated.** Eliminates reference to school districts in statute requiring consideration of metropolitan systems plan in local planning.
- 6 **Reference eliminated.** Eliminates reference to school districts in statute establishing hearing procedures.
- 7 **Reference eliminated.** Eliminates reference to school districts in statute establishing hearing procedures.
- 8 **Capital improvement program amendments.** Eliminates requirement that school districts adopt their capital improvement programs after Met Council review and comment. Eliminates decennial review of school district capital improvement programs.
- 9 **Application clause.** Applies in the seven-county metropolitan area.
