## Bill Summary

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### Overview

Proposes to include technology and information literacy standards in the common core of teaching knowledge and skills and directs the Board of Teaching to develop a seven-year cycle to review all standards of effective practice for teachers beginning in the 2007-2008 school year.

### Section

- 1** **Teacher and support personnel qualifications.** Makes technology and information literacy standards part of the common core of teaching knowledge and skills that all candidates seeking a teaching license must acquire. Requires the technology and information literacy standards to be consistent with the recommendations of the education department's educator licensing and teacher quality division. Directs the board to develop a system for reviewing on a seven-year cycle all standards of effective practice for teachers beginning in the 2007-2008 school year.
