Overview

This bill changes child passenger restraint system training requirements.

Section

- 1 Child passenger restraint systems; training requirements. Amends Minnesota Statutes 2005 Supplement, §245A.18, subdivision 2.
 - Changes the requirement that programs licensed by the Department of Human Services that serve a children under nine years of age complete child passenger restraint training to programs that serve children under school age, as defined in §245A.02, subdivision 16.
 - Adds that programs and individuals using only buses or school buses to transport children shall be exempt from the requirements in this subdivision.
- **Effective date.** Section 1 is effective July 1, 2006.
