Overview

This bill increases the bushel threshold related to grain buyer financial statements from 150,000 to 1,500,000 bushels. Grain buyers purchasing less than 1,500,000 bushels per calendar year could submit a financial statement prepared by a public accountant who is not an employee or relative. In addition to a financial statement, grain buyers purchasing more than 1,500,000 bushels must also submit a reviewed financial statement/audit or a compilation report prepared by an approved grain commission firm.

Background: For the purpose of fixing or changing the amount of a required bond or for any other proper reason, state law requires licensed grain buyers to submit an annual financial statement.
