Overview

The Bureau of Criminal Apprehension (BCA) is creating a new indexing service of individuals who have had contact with the criminal justice system. The bill classifies data in this service as private (available to the data subject but not anyone else outside the BCA) but makes it confidential (not available to the subject or anyone else) if the private data is joined with confidential data.
