Overview

Provides that members of state boards and advisory groups may receive compensation at the daily rate of \$75 (rather than the current \$55) if the amount of time spent on the group's activity for a day is more than eight hours.

Section

1 **Boards.** Provides that members of state boards may be compensated at the rate of \$75 for a day spent on board activity if the amount of time spent on board activity (including travel to and from the member's home) is more than eight hours for that day.

Requires boards to adopt internal standards on how to document this time.

2 **Advisory councils and committees.** Provides that members of state advisory groups may be compensated at the rate of \$75 for a day spent on the group's activity if the amount of time spent on board activity (including travel to and from the member's home) is more than eight hours for that day.

Requires groups to adopt internal standards on how to document this time.
