Overview

This bill establishes group residential pilot projects in Ramsey and Hennepin counties.

Section

- 1 Mental health pilot program for unsheltered individuals.
 - **Subd. 1. Pilot project program components.** Instructs the commissioner of human services to establish two pilot projects, one in Ramsey County and the other in Hennepin County. These projects shall operate two ten-bed facilities in separate locations; provide community support to individuals who have been homeless for at least one year; provide 24-hour supervision; and provide on-site mental health services.
 - **Subd. 2. Group residential housing.** States that a county agency shall negotiate a supplementary rate in addition to the rate specified in §256I.05, subdivision 1, not to exceed \$700 per month, including authorized inflationary adjustments.
 - **Subd. 3. Independent living.** Provides that an individual remains eligible for group residential housing and the supplementary service rate negotiated with the county under subdivision 2 when transitioned to independent living.
 - **Subd. 4. Effective date.** This section is effective July 1, 2006, through June 30, 2008.
