Overview

This bill makes various technical changes to commercial feed law. Specifically, the bill:

- replaces the term "registrant" with "license holder;"
- changes commercial feed distributors' recordkeeping requirements;
- adds "specialty pet foods" to the commissioner of agriculture's rulemaking purview;
- requires the guarantor of a commercial feed sample found to be adulterated or misbranded to provide the commissioner with a manufacturer's report of investigation; and
- makes other minor changes.
