| Subject: | Removing the five-year limit on Limited English Proficiency Funding | | |
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Overview

A school district is eligible for both basic Limited English Proficiency (LEP) and LEP concentration funding. A school district's basic LEP funding equals \$700 times the district's LEP pupil count. A school district's LEP concentration funding equals \$250 times its LEP pupil count times the lesser of one or the ratio of the district's percent LEP pupils to 11.5 percent. A LEP pupil only counts for funding for five years or until the student is proficient in English, whichever comes first.

This bill removes the five-year limit on funded services and also lowers the LEP formula allowances to the amounts that existed prior to the 2003 legislative session beginning with revenue for fiscal year 2006.

Section

- **1 Pupil of limited English proficiency.** Removes the five year limit on LEP funding beginning in fiscal year 2006.
- 2 School district LEP revenue. Lowers the regular LEP formula amount from \$700 per LEP pupil to \$584 per LEP pupil unit beginning in FY 2006.
- **3 Basic skills revenue.** Lowers the LEP concentration formula allowance from \$250 to \$190 times the number of LEP students times the LEP concentration ratio.
