Overview

This bill modifies two statutory provisions relating to petroleum tank release cleanup.

Section

- Retail locations and transport vehicles. Modifies the definition of "transport vehicle" to refer to a liquid fuel cargo tank used to deliver gasoline into underground storage tanks during 2002 or 2003 at a retail location. (Current law refers to liquid fuel cargo tanks used during 2002 and 2003.) Makes this section effective retroactively from August 1, 2003.
- **Appropriation.** Notwithstanding the statutory provision governing applications for reimbursement from the petroleum tank release cleanup fund, appropriates \$477,500 in fiscal year 2007 and \$477,500 in fiscal year 2008 from the petroleum tank release cleanup fund to the commissioner of transportation for costs reimbursable under section 115C.09 that were incurred before January 1, 2004.
