Overview

Victory Memorial Drive Historic District was designated as an historic district by the legislature in 2003. The district is comprised of the drive extending from Lowry Avenue North on the south to Humboldt Avenue North on the east, and all property associated with the drive owned by the Minneapolis Park and Recreation Board. This bill establishes a task force to develop strategies for implementation of a master plan for restoration of the district.

Section

- 1** **Task force established.** Establishes a task force to develop strategies for implementation of a master plan for restoration of the Victory Memorial Drive Historic District.
- 2** **Membership.** Membership to consist of thirteen members from designated cities, counties, the state historical society, the legislature and veterans organizations.
- 3** **Report.** Requires biennial report to the legislature.
- 4** **Staff support.** Designates various state and city offices to provide staff support to the task force.
- 5** **Compensation.** Task force members may be compensated according to the general law applicable to administrative boards and agencies, which provides for a \$55 per diem and actual expenses.
- 6** **Sunset.** Task force sunsets on December 31, 2009.
