Overview

Clarifies that the education department is authorized to investigate certain reports of child maltreatment.

Section

- Persons mandated to report. Requires a person who is mandated to report physical or sexual child abuse or neglect within a facility or school to report the information to the agency responsible for assessing or investigating the report if the facility is not licensed by the human services commissioner.
- Department of Education responsible for assessing or investigating reports of maltreatment. Makes the education department responsible for assessing or investigating allegations of child maltreatment in schools unless the alleged maltreatment occurs in a program or facility licensed by the human services commissioner. Defines school to include programs that are located in or operated by a school.
- Local welfare agency, Department of Human Services or Department of Health responsible for assessing or investigating reports of maltreatment. Makes the county local welfare agency responsible for assessing or investigating allegations of maltreatment that are not the responsibility of another agency to assess or investigate.
