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## Overview

This bill modifies the allocation of revenues from the motor vehicle sales tax (MVST) and amends the phrasing of the proposed constitutional amendment dedicating 100 percent of MVST revenues to transportation.

## Section

- **Deposit of revenues.** Modifies the allocation of revenues from the motor vehicle sales tax (MVST), so that starting in fiscal year 2012, after a phase-in, the revenue is distributed as follows:
  - 60 percent goes to the highway user tax distribution fund;
  - 36 percent goes to the Metropolitan Council for metropolitan area transit; and
  - Four percent goes to the Department of Transportation for distribution to greater Minnesota.
- 2 Submission to voters. Amends the phrasing of the proposed constitutional amendment dedicating 100 percent of MVST revenues to transportation.
- 3 Effective date. Makes the modified allocation of MVST revenues in section 1 only effective upon adoption of the proposed constitutional amendment dedicating 100 percent of MVST revenues to transportation.
