### Overview

This bill deals with licensing of auctioneers, who are licensed by county auditors and regulated under chapter 330 of Minnesota Statutes.

#### Section

- 1**      **Generally.** Requires that a license issued to an auctioneer must specify the county that issued the license and must contain a number that individually identifies the auctioneer who holds the license.
- 2**      **Advertisements.** Eliminates a requirement that advertisements of auction sales contain a seven-digit license number assigned by the county auditor, with each digit having a meaning specified in the law.
- 3**      **Effective date.** Makes the bill effective immediately.
