## **Overview**

This bill places restrictions on renting and purchasing video games by persons under the age of 17.

## **Section**

- 1 Restricted Video Games; Prohibitions.
  - **Subd. 1. Definitions.** Defines "restricted video game" as a video game rated AO or M by the entertainment software rating board.
  - **Subd. 2. Prohibited acts.** Creates a petty misdemeanor penalty for persons under the age of 17 who knowingly rent or purchase a restricted video.
  - **Subd. 3. Posted signs required.** Requires retailers who sell or rent video games to post a sign that states the following: "It is against the law for a person under 17 to rent or purchase a video game rated AO or M. Violators may be subject to a \$25 penalty."
