Overview

The bill specifies the specific purposes for which a candidate and workers accompanying a candidate may seek admittance to multiple-unit residential facilities and certain single-family dwellings, and requires that the candidate and workers be permitted to leave campaign materials for residents.

Section

- 1 (a) Access Requirement. Requires that candidates who have filed for election to public office and campaign workers accompanied by a candidate be permitted access to apartment houses, dormitories, nursing homes, manufactured home parks, other multiple unit facilities, and areas with two or more single-family dwellings on private roadways, if:
 - (1) the candidate is seeking admittance solely to campaign for a candidate, register voters, or get out the vote; and
 - (2) the candidate and any accompanying campaign workers are within the territory for which the candidate has filed for election.
 - **(b) Literature Drop.** Candidates and accompanying campaign workers must be permitted to leave campaign materials for residents.
 - (c) **Penalty**. The penalty for violation is a petty misdemeanor.
