Provides for the Scott County Board to direct, operate and manage the county library system and for the county library board to advise the county board. Provides for the library board to determine the contents of the collections and for use of library meeting rooms.

This special law is substantially the same as was enacted for Washington County in 2005 and as for Hennepin County in Minn. Stat. § 383B.239 (enacted in 1981).

Under general law, Minnesota Statutes, chapter 134, a county board may appoint a library board, but once appointed, the library board has control of the operation and administration of the library system.
