Sales and purchase. Expands the definition of taxable sales and purchase to include voluntary medical procedures used to improve a person's appearance, body image, or self-esteem. Reconstructive surgery or dentistry to correct congenital defects, developmental defects, or the results of trauma, infection, or disease will not be subject to the tax. Effective after June 30, 2007.
