### Overview

Makes students who enroll in a recovery-focused high school after completing a licensed treatment program immediately eligible to participate in league-sponsored activities on the same basis as other resident district students.

#### Section

- 1** **Rules for open enrollees.** (b) Declares that a student who enrolls in or is readmitted to a recovery-focused high school after successfully completing a licensed treatment program is immediately eligible to participate on the same basis as other district students in league-sponsored activities of the student's resident school district. Does not prohibit the league from enforcing penalties on students under this paragraph who violate league or district rules.

Makes this section effective immediately.
