Overview

This bill appropriates funds for a feasibility study and predesign of a Native American juvenile treatment center.

Section

- 1 Native American juvenile treatment center; appropriation; feasibility study; predesign.** Appropriates \$100,000 to the commissioner of human services to conduct a feasibility study and to predesign a Native American juvenile treatment center. The center is to be on or near the White Earth Reservation. Allows the commissioner to contract with parties who are experienced in the design and construction of juvenile treatment centers. Requires the commissioner to present the results to the legislature on or before January 15, 2008.
