1 Sesquicentennial Commission. Makes the following amendments to the 2005 law creating the Minnesota Sesquicentennial Commission:

- Strikes the Commission's duty to plan for capital improvements.
- Authorizes the Commission to accept donations, and appropriates funds received to the Commission for the purpose of commemorating the Minnesota sesquicentennial.
- Authorizes the Commission to enter into contracts and award grants to carry out its purposes.
- Specifies conditions under which the Commission may meet by telephone or other electronic means.
