This bill changes the appearance of restricted drivers licenses that disallow any alcohol consumption (known as the B-Card). It requires that the licenses have a color matching that of "under-21" licenses (which currently use a red border around the licensee photo), and that there be a symbol or letter on the front of the license indicating that it is a B-Card. It also allows text on the back of the card describing the license restriction, and allows servers of alcohol to refuse to serve the B-Card holder.

The bill is effective August 1, 2008 .
