Local impact notes. Under current law, the commissioner of finance must coordinate development of a local impact note for proposed legislation or administrative rules upon request of the chair or the ranking minority member of the House or Senate Tax Committee. This bill changes the law to require development of a local impact note upon request of the chair or the ranking minority member of a legislative committee with jurisdiction over the proposed legislation. The bill also requires that a copy of the completed note be given to the chair and ranking minority member of all committees to which a bill is referred; and

(A local impact note estimates the local impact on each type of political subdivision that would result from the proposed legislation.)
