Overview

This bill restricts sales of vehicles that do not meet window tinting laws and modifies regulation of window tinting.

Section

- 1 **Glazing material.** Prohibits motor vehicle dealers and lessors from selling or leasing vehicles that do not comply with window tinting laws.
- 2 **Glazing material; prohibitions and exceptions.** Amends the exceptions from window tinting laws, so that:
 - the exception for initial installation of the window only applies if it was installed by the actual vehicle manufacturer;
 - the exception for medical needs only applies if the medical prescription identifies the percentage reduction of light transmittance necessary, and has an expiration date that is no longer than two years after the prescription is made; and
 - a new exception for police vehicles is established.
