Overview

This bill establishes new curriculum and driver's manual information requirements relating to interaction with trucks.

Section

- **Driver education content.** Adds a curriculum requirement for driver's education that the Department of Public Safety must adopt in rules by January 1, 2009. It consists of a section on awareness and safe interaction with trucks, covering topics like following distances, truck braking capability, and truck blind spots.
- **Driver's manual; defensive driving.** Requires that a section of awareness and safe interaction with trucks be added to the driver's manual.
- **Driver education; rulemaking.** Exempts the Department of Public Safety from most of the standard rulemaking procedures.
