### Overview

This bill regulates spotter trucks, including exempting them from titling and registration, specifying limitations on their operation on public roads, and requiring annual inspection.

#### Section

- 1 Spotter trucks.** Exempts spotter trucks from registration requirements taxes.
- 2 No certificate issued.** Directs the Department of Public Safety not to issue a certificate of title for a spotter truck.
- 3 Spotter truck.** Defines a spotter truck as a type of truck-tractor that is only used for moving semi-trailers around for freight operations.
- 4 Spotter trucks.** Establishes traffic regulations for spotter trucks, allowing them to be operated on public streets if certain conditions are met, including the driver having a commercial driver's license, compliance with truck size and weight laws, annual commercial vehicle inspections, and only being operated within 2 miles of the home facility.
- 5 Definitions.** Includes spotter trucks as commercial motor vehicle that must be annually inspected.
