Overview

This bill requires a business establishment that sells OTC meth precursor drugs to retain the sale log for five years from the date of purchase. The log contains information on the date of sale, the name of the buyer, and the amount of the drug sold. In addition, the bill requires the business to allow inspection of the log by law enforcement upon request. The business or its employee is immune from any liability arising out of release of that information.
