Overview

This bill appropriates \$5 million from the bond proceeds fund to the commissioner of human services for grants to construct and rehabilitate early childhood learning and child protection facilities and requires the commissioner of finance to sell and issue bonds for this purpose.

Section

1 Early childhood learning and child protection facilities; appropriation.

Subd. 1. Appropriation. Appropriates \$5 million from the bond proceeds fund to the commissioner of human services for grants to construct and rehabilitate early childhood learning and child protection facilities.

Subd. 2. Bond sale. Requires the commissioner of finance to sell and issue bonds of the state in an amount up to \$5 million to provide the money appropriated in this section.

2 Effective date. Makes this section effective the day following final enactment.
