## 1 [325F.696] [LOST OR STOLEN CELLULAR PHONES.]

**Subd. 1. Unauthorized use.** Provides that a person is not liable for any charges for use of a cellular phone after the person notifies the service provider that the phone has been lost or stolen, and from which the person or a member of the person's household or family derives no benefit.

**Subd. 2. Unauthorized use defined.** Defines "unauthorized use" as use by a person other than the customer who does not have actual, implied, or apparent authority for the use.
