This bill exempts certain cargo tank trucks from seasonal weight limits and weight restrictions imposed by the Minnesota Department of Transportation. In order to be exempt:

- The vehicle must have two or three axles and in use for delivering propane or dyed fuel oil
- The cargo tank cannot be more than 50 percent full
- If the vehicle is for propane, it must have a gauge on the tank for identifying the percent by which the tank is full, with documentation carried in the vehicle cab on the capacity of the tank
- If the vehicle is for fuel oil, it must carry documentation from a certified scale on the empty weight of the cargo tank
