This bill reflects organizational changes in the Bureau of Criminal Apprehension (BCA). The two-information service divisions at the BCA – the CriMNet Program Office and the Criminal Justice Information Systems (CJIS) – were reorganized into one new organization, MN Justice Information Services (MNJIS). The changes reflect the name of the new organization, or in some cases, provide a more general reference to the BCA.

- Replaces CJIS reference with general BCA reference (Sections 1, 2, 7, 18-22, 24)
- Deletes CJIS references (Sections 3, 5-14, 17)
- Deletes CriMNet reference (Sections 5, 15, 16, 23)
- Adds reference to section 13.87 for "criminal history data" (Sections 2-5, 21, 22)
- Adds a reference to "Integrated Search Service" as defined in section 13.873 (Sections 5, 23)
- Adds a reference to "criminal justice data communications network" as defined in section 299C.46 (Section 7)
- Amends the duties of the Criminal and Juvenile Justice Information Policy Group to include the responsibility for the integration of statewide criminal justice information (Section 15)
