This bill expands the list of purposes for which law enforcement may access data in the Comprehensive Incident-Based Reporting System (CIBRS). The bill adds four additional purposes to the list: (1) to serve process in a criminal case; (2) to inform law enforcement of possible safety issues prior to service of process; (3) to enforce no contact orders; and (4) to locate missing persons.
