## Overview

This bill contains a series of statutory changes related to controlled substance offenders and the early conditional release program for nonviolent drug offenders.

## Section

- 5<sup>th</sup> **Degree Controlled Substance Crimes.** Permits a court to disregard the six month mandatory minimum sentence for repeat fifth degree controlled substance offenders if the court finds on its own motion or the motion of the prosecutor that there are substantial and compelling reasons to disregard the mandatory minimum.
- **Release procedures.** Requires the commissioner to consult with a three-judge board before the commissioner denies conditional release to an eligible offender.
- **Advisory board.** Directs the Chief Justice to appoint three retired judges to advise the commissioner of corrections on early release decisions.
- **Sunset.** Extends the sunset for the nonviolent drug offender conditional release program for two years.
