### Section

- 1**      **Review of reports.** Requires the Sentencing Guidelines Commission to review its reports for possible consolidation or elimination to achieve administrative convenience or fiscal savings.
- 2**      **Repealer.** Repeals reports required under §§ 260B.199, subd. 2, and 260B.201, subd. 3.  
  
These subdivisions require a court to submit a report to the Sentencing Guidelines Commission when it places a juvenile offender in an out-of-state facility. The reports must provide information on how the safety of the child or community can best be met by the placement, or that the out-of-state facility is closer to the child's home. The reports must also provide reasons for not placing the child in an in-state facility, including MCF-Red Wing. Directs the commission to forward a summary of this data to the legislature annually.
