This bill expands a prohibition on putting certain speeding violations on a person's driving record. It prohibits speed limit violations of up to (and including) ten miles per hour over the speed limit in 55 and 60 miles per hour zones from going on the driving record.

Under current law, this prohibition applies if traveling (1) up to ten miles per hour over the limit in a 55 miles per hour zone, and (2) up to five miles per hours over the limit in a 60 miles per hour zone.
