Nutrition. Amends §148.624, subd. 2. Current law instructs the board to issue a nutritionist license (1) to a person who has received a master's or doctoral degree and has completed a specified number of supervised practice hours, or (2) to a person who has qualified as a diplomate of the American Board of Nutrition, Springfield, Virginia.

This bill strikes clause (2) and adds that a person who has received certification as a Certified Nutrition Specialist by the Certification Board for Nutrition Specialists can be licensed as a nutritionist.

Repealer. Repeals §148.627. This section is obsolete.
