Overview

This bill permits a domestic partner to be the beneficiary of an award of damages resulting from a wrongful death suit.

Section

- Wrongful death claims against the state. Permits a wrongful death claim against the state of Minnesota to be brought by a domestic partner of the deceased person.
- Wrongful death claims against a local unit of government. Permits a wrongful death claim against a local unit of government to be brought by a domestic partner of the deceased person.
- Wrongful death damages. Permits the financial recovery in a wrongful death action to be for the exclusive benefit of a surviving domestic partner in addition to next of kin.

A definition of "domestic partner" is provided.

Trustee for action. Permits a domestic partner to file a petition requesting a court appoint a trustee to continue or commence a claim for damages resulting from the deceased person's injury and death.
