Overview

Authorizes state agencies to give rulemaking notices by electronic mail. Current law requires notices to be given by United States mail.

Section

- **1 Style and form revisions.** Authorizes giving notice by electronic mail when the Revisor is proposing style and form revisions of rules.
- 2 Notice of rule hearing. Authorizes giving notice by electronic mail when a state agency is holding a public hearing on proposed rules.
- **3 Notice of intent to adopt rules without public hearing.** Authorizes giving notice by electronic mail when a state agency is proposing to adopt rules without holding a public hearing.
- **4 Expedited rulemaking process.** Authorizes giving notice by electronic mail when a state agency is using an expedited process to adopt proposed rules.
- 5 **Repeal of obsolete rules.** Authorizes giving notice by electronic mail when a state agency is proposing to repeal obsolete rules.
