**1 Intermediate auction sales; maximum lots of 3,000 cords.** Amends § 90.121. Limits bidders participating in intermediate timber auctions to those who employ 30 or fewer loggers (currently the limit is 20 employees). Establishes a procedure for other bidders and the commissioner of natural resources to resolve disputes over whether a bidder meets this employee threshold requirement by requiring workers' compensation insurance payment history from the Department of Labor and Industry to be used in making final determinations.
