Designates the Honor and Remember Flag as the symbol for the state's concern and commitment to those who have lost their lives in the line of duty as members of the armed forces. Suggests days for displaying the flag, leaving the decision to the chief administrator of each governmental building or facility. Does not allow an employee to be required to report to work solely to display the flag. Provides that any public office or public official may accept a donation of one or more Honor and Remember Flags to carry out the purposes of this section.
