Subject:	City of Canby – tax increment financing (TIF) authority	
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This bill authorizes the city of Canby to certify a TIF district in a defined area of the city with an original tax capacity of zero. The district has a duration limit of 21 years of increment. The city is authorized to use the increments to pay its obligations on bonds for its TIF district No. 1-21.

The city decertified district No. 21-1 at the direction of the Office of State Auditor, because it had not satisfied the requirements under the law for a housing TIF district. This bill would allow the city to essentially certify a new TIF district in the same area with a zero original net tax capacity and to use increments to pay off the debts of district No. 21-1. The bill does not specify whether the district's increments may be used for any other purposes.
