### Section

- 1** **Permit requirements.** Amends § 84D.108, subd. 2. Exempts a person working for a service provider at a resort from invasive species training requirements applicable to employees of such providers. Requires the service provider to be responsible for the direct supervision of employees exempted under this provision. A “service provider” is an “individual who or entity that installs or removes water-related equipment or structures from waters of the state for hire or as a service provided as a benefit of membership in a yacht club, boat club, marina, or similar organization.”
